# MOM Care Docs –Pregnancy and Delivery Care by Family Docs

**MOM Care Docs** is a group of female family physicians providing pregnancy and delivery care to low-risk maternity patients in Edmonton and surrounding areas.

Previously two separate groups, **MOM Care** and **Pregnancy Docs** decided to join forces effective April 6th, 2009, to create one large group of 11 physicians to better care for you and your baby.

Our office is located in the **Allin Clinic** with \$2/hr pay parking and convenient nearby bus service.



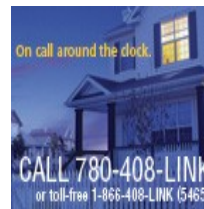
Our goal is to provide comprehensive care throughout your pregnancy, attend your delivery at the **Royal Alexandra Hospital**, and provide postpartum care (six weeks after delivery).



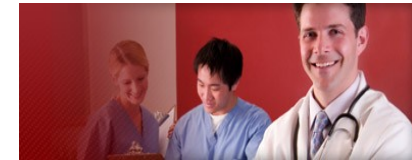
We accept **self referrals** as well as referrals from physicians, various clinics, planned parenthood and public health centers. We accept patients on an **appointment only** basis and encourage you to book in a manner that is convenient to you (i.e. always with one doctor or with a different doctor each visit).

If you do not have a family doctor, we strongly encourage you to find one as we provide care for your **pregnancy only** and not other medical problems. To find physicians taking new patients contact **Capital Health Link** at **(780)408-LINK**.

Please let us know who you want to care for your baby: your **family physician** or **pediatrician**. We can take care of your baby in hospital if your practitioner does not do so.



When you are admitted to the hospital, the **doctor on call** will be the one to attend your birth.



We provide medical education to **residents** (doctors in training). These residents are involved in your care at the clinic and at the hospital.
